■■■ Getting There

Jurong Medical Centre (JMC) is next to The Frontier Community Club at Jurong West Central 3. The Jurong West Community Library is co-located within the Frontier Community Club.

By Car : The Pan-Island Expressway (Exit 36 from PIE) is the nearest expressway (highway) leading to JMC.

Where to Park?

- a) at JMC Carpark
- b) at the HDB Miltistorey Carpark Blk 686, Jurong West Central 3 (located opposite JMC)

By Taxi : Please alight along Jurong West Central 1.

By Foot : Cross the road at the traffic light behind Jurong Point to Jurong West Community Library. JMC is left to the library.

Child Development Unit (CDU) @ Jurong Medical Centre

The Child Development Unit (CDU) is a multi-disciplinary service staffed by paediatricians with developmental training and experience, and allied health professionals including educational psychologists, speech therapists, occupational therapists, medical social workers, learning support teachers and a physiotherapist. Our aims are to provide holistic care for children with developmental, learning and behavioural issues. Services include assessments, diagnostic and intervention services, through a family-centred and community-based approach. We assist children through working closely with schools and other service providers to support their needs.

Children under 7 years old with developmental, learning or behavioural concerns can be referred to CDU. Conditions include difficulties or delays in the following:

- ◆ Gross motor development (including delays in sitting, crawling, walking etc.)
- ◆ Fine motor development (including handwriting delays)
- ◆ Speech and language development
- ◆ Overall development (including global delays or intellectual disability from genetic causes e.g. Down Syndrome)
- ◆ Attention and Activity Levels (including possible Attention Deficit and Hyperactivity Disorder)
- ◆ Socialisation (including Autistic Spectrum Disorder)
- ◆ Temperament and Behaviours (including temper tantrums, the shy child etc.)
- ◆ School difficulties or readiness for school (related to behavioural and/or academic difficulties)
- ◆ Evaluation and continuing care for premature infants.



Types of Assessment

We provide the following assessments, depending on the needs of your child:

- ◆ Autism assessment
- ◆ Educational assessments (e.g. IQ test, school readiness assessment, reading assessment)
- ◆ Neurodevelopmental assessment (evaluation of a child's learning profile)
- ◆ Speech and Language assessment
- ◆ Fine and Gross Motor assessment
- ◆ Sensory Processing assessment, including the Sensory Integration and Praxis Test (SIPT)
- ◆ Visual Perceptual and Visual-Motor assessment
- ◆ Behaviour assessment
- ◆ Play assessment

Types of Therapy and Program

- ◆ Medical consultation and anticipatory guidance
- ◆ Speech therapy
- ◆ Occupational therapy
- ◆ Physiotherapy
- ◆ Learning support program
- ◆ Behavioural intervention program
- ◆ Group therapy and programs e.g. on social skills, language and communication skills, motor skills
- ◆ Autism-specific programs eg. Hanen program, school readiness, social skills training
- ◆ Parent training and parent educational workshops
- ◆ Parent support groups
