What Our Clinic Offers

Vaccinations Available

We offer a comprehensive range of routine vaccines:

- Haemophilus influenzae type B
- Human Papilloma Virus 9-valent (Gardasil 9)
- Influenza
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella Combined
- Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV13 or PCV20)
- Pneumococcal polysaccharide (Pneumovax 23)
- Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Boostrix)
- Recombinant Zoster (Shingrix)
- Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV)
- Varicella

Note: Vaccine availability varies based on supply

Blood Tests and Serologies Available

We offer a wide range of blood tests and serologies:

- Hepatitis A IgG antibody
- Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg)
- Hepatitis B surface antibody (anti-HBs)
- Measles IgG antibody
- Mumps IgG antibody
- Rabies virus antibody
- Rubella IgG antibody
- Varicella-zoster virus IgG antibody
- HIV Screen
- TB Quantiferon

Note: Release of results will vary based on blood test request



Important Vaccination Guidelines

Before Your Vaccination

- Schedule your consultation to review your immunisation history and discuss any health concerns or allergies with our specialists
- Kindly bring along your immunisation records and blood test results if available

After Vaccination

Common side effects are mild and usually resolves within a few days. These typically include:

- Pain, swelling or redness at injection site
- Fever, headache, muscle ache or fatigue

Seek immediate medical attention if you experience shortness of breath, skin rashes, swelling of eyes, face or lips, or persistent fever $\geq 38^{\circ}\text{C}$.

Important Safety Notes

- Follow the recommended vaccination schedule for optimal protection
- Inform the doctor of any medications you're currently taking, recent illnesses or potential pregnancy plans
