Genomic Assessment Process



1



Pre-test genetic counselling to understand the condition and tests offered

2



Sample collection via blood test

3



Blood sample sent for genetic testing

4



Post-test genetic counselling to understand the result and implications

5



Results may be shared with your healthcare provider

6



Sharing of results with at-risk family members, with your consent

GAC Fees
