



NUWoC Fetal Medicine Clinic

The NUWoC Fetal Medicine Clinic provides specialised care for couples whose baby has been diagnosed with an abnormality, or couples who face difficult decisions about their pregnancy due to medical reasons.

What can I expect at my Fetal Medicine Clinic appointment?

Your appointment at the Fetal Medicine Clinic may include the following:

- 1. A detailed ultrasound scan of your baby
- 2. Consultations with:
 - Obstetrician; and
 - Paediatrician specialising in genetics; and/or
 - Paediatrician specialising in the condition detected in your baby (e.g., Paediatric Cardiologist, Paediatric Nephrologist, Neonatologist)

The total estimated charges for your first visit may range from S\$870 to S\$1,070 (inclusive of 9% GST). Charges may differ for Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, Resident Foreigners and Non-Residents.

The charges would also vary depending on the type of scan and consultation that you require.

How long will the consultation at the Fetal Medicine Clinic take?

As your visit to the clinic may involve several different consultations and/or investigations, you may wish to set aside half a day for the visit.

What happens after my visit to Fetal Medicine Clinic?

A follow-up appointment or procedure will be scheduled after you have consulted the doctor(s) at the Fetal Medicine Clinic. If you have been referred to the Fetal Medicine Clinic by your obstetrician, the consultation details from this visit will be conveyed to your primary obstetrician.

Depending on your condition, there may be recommended tests such as prenatal genetic tests which could be undertaken in local or overseas labs. The charges for such tests are estimated to range from \$\$500 to \$\$8,000. This excludes the cost of the procedure to obtain the sample from your fetus, such as an amniocentesis or a chorionic villus sampling. Your doctor will discuss the ideal recommended test/s with you.
