• There is no salary, no stipend, no allowance, no financial commitment and no accommodation from NUH for Honorary Clinical Fellowships. Requirements	• Good academic record and at least 2 referees' reports • Proof of citizenship in your country or permanent residents of Singapore • Have a basic medical degree from an accredited medical university or medical school • Have passed the relevant national licensing examination in the country of conferment of basic degree, where applicable • Have evidence of at least 12 months housemanship / internship with a certificate of satisfactory completion of housemanship or equivalent • Be registered as a medical practitioner in the country where you are currently practising • At least 3 years' experience as a Medical Officer after Housemanship/Internship • Be in active practice for the 3 years preceding the application for medical registration in Singapore • Be certified to be of good standing by the Medical Council or the relevant national authority • Please note that you must be sponsored by (i) the government, or (ii) regional health authority or (iii) an appropriate institution in the home country. For (iii), the doctor must be on current full-time employment (40 hours or more per week) with the sponsoring institution. • If the teaching medium in your Basic Medical Degree is <u>not in English</u>, an English Proficiency Test result is required, subject to a 2-year validity period based on the date of the test (<i>^refer to last page below for tests and results acceptable by SMC</i>). + Any additional requirements set by the respective NUH training programs (you may enquire with us or department) • Proof of medical fitness and immunity related to: ○ Hepatitis B ○ Hepatitis C ○ HIV ○ Varicella ○ Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)

Important Notes	Applicants should <u>not</u> make travel arrangements to Singapore yet until advised to do so. Do also note that after arrival in Singapore, we will need to meet you in NUH for backend registration with SMC. There will be at least 2 weeks waiting time for the Medical Registration Certificate & Practicing Certificate to be issued by SMC after the registration. <u>During these 2 weeks, the programme cannot commence yet.</u> Therefore, please add 2 weeks to your leave application for this attachment.

Test and results below are acceptable by SMC*:

Test results obtained from the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or Occupational English Test (OET), within the minimum score accepted by SMC can be considered, subject to a **2-year validity period based on the date of the test.**

Language Proficiency Test	Minimum Requirements
IELTS (UK) (International English Language Testing Systems)	At least 7 in each of the four components (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking) for the academic module.
TOEFL (US) (Test of English Language as a Foreign Language)	Only TOEFL Internet based test (iBT) will be accepted. TOEFL iBT score of at least 25 in each of the four components (listening, reading, writing and speaking). The overall score must be at least 100.
OET (Australia) (Occupational English Test)	At least Grade B in each of the four components (listening, reading, writing and speaking).
