

## **ABDOMINAL PAIN**

Abdominal pain is a general symptom that can arise from anywhere within the abdomen or from nearby organs. Should any of the following occur, please seek further medical attention.

### **Visit an Emergency Department if:**

1. The abdominal pain increases or becomes constant in one specific area.
2. You vomit blood or blackish fluid.
3. Your stools become bloody or black in colour.
4. Your urine becomes blood-tinged.
5. You develop bloody vaginal discharge (for women).
6. Your abdomen becomes swollen.
7. You are unable to pass urine.
8. You are dizzy or faint or lethargic.
9. You have a temperature over 39°C.
10. You develop other symptoms such as shortness of breath or chest pain.
