

## Fractures



Has sprains / bruise

- Has swelling, bruising or redness
- Has difficulty placing weight on the area
- Has broken bones but are not out of alignment
- Has worsening swelling, bruising or redness
- Has difficulty placing weight on the area
- Has deformed bones and out of alignment


## Cuts



 Has abrasions without skin breakage

- Has superficial cuts
- Has bleeding that stops after pressure is applied to wound
- Has deep cuts
- Has visible bones
- Has bleeding that does not stop despite applying pressure


## Minor Head Injuries



- Is above 3 months old
- Has a fall from a height of less than 90cm
- Has mild bruising
- Is back to his/her usual self and able to drink well after
- Is above 3 months old
- Has a fall from a height of less than 90cm
- Has moderate swelling or bruising at injury site
- Has mild headache
- Has less than 3
  episodes of vomiting
- Is back to his/her usual self and able to drink well after

- Has a fall from a height of more than 90cm or a high impact head injury
- Has a large boggy swelling at injury site
- Has a fit or fainted after impact
- Is lethargic, weak or unsteady
- Has more than 3 episodes of vomiting

## Burns



 Has a small area of redness without blisters

- Has a small area of redness with or without blisters
- Has excessive burns that cover the face or genitalia
- Has a large area of redness (5 times or more than the size of child's palm)
