<b>Fractures</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has sprains / bruise</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has swelling, bruising or redness</li> <li>Has difficulty placing weight on the area</li> <li>Has broken bones but are not out of alignment</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has worsening swelling, bruising or redness</li> <li>Has difficulty placing weight on the area</li> <li>Has deformed bones and out of alignment</li> </ul>
<b>Cuts</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has abrasions without skin breakage</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has superficial cuts</li> <li>Has bleeding that stops after pressure is applied to wound</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has deep cuts</li> <li>Has visible bones</li> <li>Has bleeding that does not stop despite applying pressure</li> </ul>
<b>Minor Head Injuries</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is above 3 months old</li> <li>Has a fall from a height of less than 90cm</li> <li>Has mild bruising</li> <li>Is back to his/her usual self and able to drink well after</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is above 3 months old</li> <li>Has a fall from a height of less than 90cm</li> <li>Has moderate swelling or bruising at injury site</li> <li>Has mild headache</li> <li>Has less than 3 episodes of vomiting</li> <li>Is back to his/her usual self and able to drink well after</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a fall from a height of more than 90cm or a high impact head injury</li> <li>Has a large boggy swelling at injury site</li> <li>Has a fit or fainted after impact</li> <li>Is lethargic, weak or unsteady</li> <li>Has more than 3 episodes of vomiting</li> </ul>
<b>Burns</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a small area of redness without blisters</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has a small area of redness with or without blisters</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has excessive burns that cover the face or genitalia</li> <li>Has a large area of redness (5 times or more than the size of child's palm)</li> </ul>
