- Majoring in Psychology, and
- At least in their 3rd year of study

- Curriculum Vitae (with photograph).
- Cover letter detailing the following:
 - Tell us about yourself (e.g. hobbies, interests, goals, etc).
 - Why do you want to attend POP@NUH.
 - What do you hope to achieve from this experience.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FULL PROGRAMME PARTICIPANTS

- You must obtain Hospital Insurance and the required vaccinations, at your own cost, to attend the programme.
- The required vaccinations are:
 - MMR: 2-dose vaccination record or IgB blood tests (mumps/measles/rubella) all showing immunity.
 - VZV: 2-dose vaccination record or IgG blood test showing immunity.
 - Boostrix Tdap: vaccination record within the past 10 years
 - COVID vaccination: primary series + 1 booster based on Singapore's standards.
- We will contact you with more details about the requirements and programme once your attendance is confirmed
